2. Advise the executive management teams of the combined companies regarding legal disputes and litigation and assist in the management of the defense, prosecution, negotiation, and settlement of such disputes and litigation.
3. Educate the executive management teams of the combined companies on emerging areas of law and legislation affecting the entertainment software industry.
4. Manage and work with outside legal counsel in corporate, litigation, and licensing matters.
